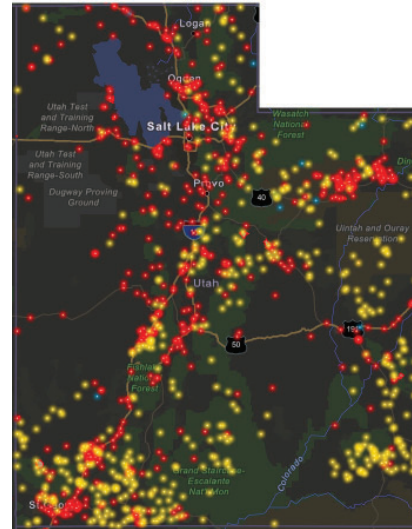




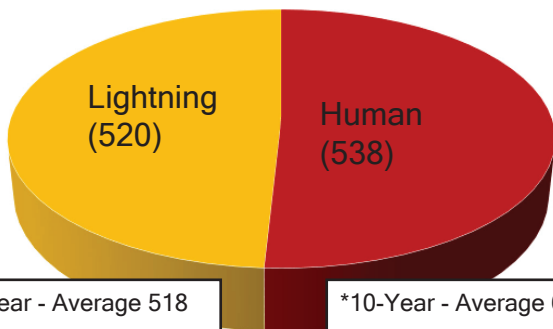
# UTAH'S 2021 WILDFIRE SEASON

(AS OF SEPT 12, 2021)

- 1,058 wildfires suppressed (plus 230 False Alarms)
- 62,407 Acres burned (38%, or 23,454 human caused)
- Lightning-caused fires are ahead of the 10-year average.
- Human-caused fires are below the 10-year average.



## 2021 Human vs. Lightning Wildfires

At least one wildfire start every day between May 17 and August 23.

# 93%

of all wildfires this year were stopped before reaching 10 acres in size.

- Pack Creek 8,952 Acres (Grand/San Juan Co.)
- Bennion Crk 8,313 Acres (Utah Co.)
- Little Pass 2,186.0 Acres (Tooele Co.)

## Homes/Structures

- Homes protected 3,043
- Secondary structures protected - 807
- Homes destroyed - 16
- Secondary structures destroyed - 22

2021 Estimated cost for wildfire suppression for all state, local, and federal agencies: \$42 million  
2021 Estimated cost to the State: \$22 million
